Julián Gadano is the Deputy Secretary of Nuclear Energy, for the Ministry of Treasury in Argentina, appointed in December 2015 when the new Administration took office; and in 2019 he was appointed President of Nucleoeléctrica Argentina S.A - the nuclear power plants operator.

Previously, he was a member of the Nuclear Regulatory Authority's Directory, an independent body in charge of regulating nuclear safety. Where he was in charge of international issues (such as non-proliferation and international security) in interaction with the Foreign Ministry, the National Atomic Energy Commission and agencies in other countries. He has been working in the nuclear sector for the past 10 years.

He is a Sociologist from the Universidad de Buenos Aires. He is currently taking Master's and Ph.D. studies in Political Science at Universidad Torcuato Di Tella.

He has a large trajectory in education. He is a professor for Undergraduate and Graduate programs in Universidad de San Andrés.

He is an author of several papers on nuclear cooperation, non-proliferation and issues related with technological developments.
